

**SOCIETY ACT CONSTITUTION
OF THE
WEST ZION MENNONITE CHURCH
CARSTAIRS, ALBERTA**

October 21, 2003

Article I

The name of the society is the WEST ZION MENNONITE CHURCH

Article II

The purposes of the society are:

1. To serve this church body through the ministry of God's Word, in encouraging and maturing of the saints, in developing personal ministry in the body and assisting each to find and function in their ministry in the body.
2. To assist and promote in the fulfillment of the Great Commission.
3. To endeavor to work with the Christian community at large in fellowship and godly endeavor.
4. To teach and practice the doctrines of the Christian faith as commonly accepted from a biblical Mennonite perspective.
5. To buy, hold, sell or lease real property or dispose of the property of the society or any part of the property of the society as the society may deem necessary.

Article III

To assure that the society shall be carried on without purpose of gain to its directors or members and any profits or other accretions to the society shall be used in promoting its purposes.

Article IV

That at all times the society will ensure that it will comply with all rules and regulations governing societies.

Article V

The directors and trustees of the society shall be the Elder Board.

Article VI

If the society is dissolved, the property of the society shall be transferred to the Northwest Mennonite Conference.

Article VII

In the event of a division in the congregation, the property of the society shall reside with those who are recognized as the true congregation by the Northwest Mennonite Conference.
